**Sub:- Unjustified allotments of quarters at M. O. Mumbai.**

R/Sir,

Since July- 2013 this administration has start showing sign of either strange decision or unable to take decision when immediate actions are required. One of which is very sensitive issue of quarters at RS/RW santacruz. During the month of August-2013 new DDGM had issued notice to vacate RS/RW quarters. NGSU has strongly objected for this order and asked office to provide alternate arrangement before asking staff to vacate quarters. Also NGSU was suspicious about intervence of private parties as during this time concerned parties many times visited office. So it has held series of meeting and took assurance from administration that staff and officers staying in RS/RW quarters will not be asked to vacate quarters until alternate accommodation is made available.


In one such meeting ADMINISTRATION has made it very clear that they will give priority to RS/RW staff whenever quarters get vacated at M.O. SCZ. It was calculated that most of these staff can be accommodated to M.O.SCZ due to either retirement of staff at M.O. SCZ or shifting staff and officers to Type-III and Type IV. On such background it was necessary for administration to keep watch and show alertness while allotting and vacating quarter at M. O. Mumbai. For e.g. Shri V. V. Karmarkar is not ready to vacate Type II quarter after superannuation. Here administration need to take strong step at RMC level only but now they are engaged in dialogue with HQ and the staff is still occupying quarter for more than one year after his retirement. Where as Shri S.R. Shukla, AM-II had been denied extension after superannuation on similar ground.

One more interesting fact to put forth that Shri R.A. Chandekar A.M.II , who in spite of his entitlement for Type- IV quarter was occupying Type-III quarter at RS/RW . He was allotted Type-IV quarter at M.O. Scz in the month of August-2013. But he was not ready to occupy the allotted quarter. NGSU has repeatedly asked administration to cancel his allotment and give same quarter to next eligible staff so that vacated Type-III quarter can be allotted to suffering staff at RS/RW. Here fast action was expected from office but unfortunately again office failed to take decision.

The height of all issues is that, administration has issued him reminder notice 15-20 days prior to his retirement i.e. in July-2014 for occupying allotted (instead of cancellation order of allotment) quarter. This officer who was not ready to vacate quarter at RS/RW, given key on last day of his retirement and he occupied quarter after his retirement. If administration had taken appropriate decision at appropriate time this incidence would not have arisen. This kind of sheer negligence is seen since in last one year. Now it is very interesting to watch how administration vacates these quarters.

We hope DGM New Delhi will make a note of our grievances and issue instruction to concern, so that we will not be put in a situation to put our grievances to higher authority and matter will be solved at RMC level itself.
